Bury Agricultural Show Equestrian Rules of Entry

- ❖ All prize money **MUST** be collected on day of the show or will be forfeit.
- ❖ Only Horseboxes and Cars towing trailers will be allowed into the horse parking area.
- ❖ Entries would be appreciated via Entrymaster. Entries close at Midnight, **Sunday 21st June 2026**. Late entries will be accepted if space allows. If you wish to enter on the day, this will include a supplement fee of £5.00 per class if you have already entered the same horse/pony or are sharing a vehicle already planned to be at the show.
- ❖ Competitor first aid must be paid for when submitting entries. (£2)
- ❖ Each exhibitor will receive 2 tickets; additional tickets can be booked in advance.
 - ❖ The organisers accept no responsibility for loss or damage, injury or accident to spectators, exhibitors, riders or their property as a result of attending this show. Please take appropriate care to prevent such accident or loss to yourselves and others. All competitors must hold suitable Public Liability insurance and a valid equine passport.
- ❖ Equine Influenza – all animals to have received an annual vaccination within 12 months of the show or if have had to start a new course proof of the 1st & 2nd vaccinations will be required.
- ❖ Riders must wear up to date hard hats secured with a chin strap.
- ❖ No persons other than the exhibitor, handler, judges and stewards are allowed into the rings.
- ❖ Age for horse/pony and rider as of 1st January 2026
- ❖ All stallions and colts should be suitably bitted and handled by persons 16 yrs. and over.
- ❖ The organiser's reserve the right to divide, amalgamate or cancel any classes should entries warrant it.
- ❖ The Judge's decision is final. Any formal objections should be made in writing (official form available from the Secretary's marquee) and handed to the Secretary, accompanied by a deposit of £20, before leaving the show. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld. You will be notified of the decision by post.
 - ❖ No horse/pony to be left unattended tied outside a horsebox/trailer.
- ❖ No mucking out on the showground.
- ❖ Mistreatment of any animal on the Showground will not be tolerated. The organisers reserve the right to ask anyone to leave.
- ❖ By entering any class, you agree to abide by the rules above. The above rules are additional to the general show rules.

Rosettes to 5th Place

"This show is affiliated to the Suffolk Horse Society (SHS) championship points for annually awarded trophies and for the Supreme Suffolk Horse Championship.

All entries for In Hand classes must be registered in or eligible for registration in the Pedigree Section of the UK Suffolk Stud book. All entries must state their SHS registration number and full pedigree name including prefix or affix.

All foals must be eligible for registration in the Pedigree Section of the UK Suffolk Stud Book. Both the sire and the dam must be registered and entered in the pedigree section of the UK Suffolk Stud Book. All stallions must be registered in the Pedigree Section of the UK Suffolk Stud book. All entries must state their SHS registration number, stallion licence number and full pedigree name including prefix or affix. Discretionary entry to a stallion class may be allowed in cases where a licence is pending but not yet issued. All owners entering their horses must be members of the Suffolk Horse Society".

Special Class – Best Turned-out Suffolk Horse, open to all Suffolk Horses.

Class 1 -Yearling – Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 2 - 2 and 3 year old Mare or Gelding

***Highest place of each age will receive a special rosette*.**

Class 3 - 4 years old and over Mare – open to mares and mares with foals at foot

Special rosette for best foal in show

Class 4 - Geldings 4 years old and over

Class 5 – Stallion 2 years old and over

Class 6 – Veteran (15 years and over) – Mare or Gelding

Class 7 - In hand Working Harness – The horse should be dressed in no more harness than it would be if it were to work Ridden

Class 10 – Shire Horse Broodmare (foaling 2026)

This class is a qualifier for the Shire Horse Society's Summer Brood Mare Supreme Championship with the final being held at the 2026 National Summer Show at Rockingham Castle on 27th August 2026, where the ultimate winner will receive prize money of £1,000 with £500 to second, £250 to 3rd, £100 to 4th, £50 to 5th and then £25 from 6th-10th.

Class 13 – Stallion 2 years and over

Class 14 – Veteran (15 years and over)
